- (a) To discuss the Hostel Allotment policy for the Academic year 2026-27.

**03. Decision:**

- a. After detailed discussion and deliberation Hostel Allotment Committee has finalized the allotment policy for the academic year 2026-27.
- b. The hostel wise capacity chart and course wise seat matrix for academic year 2026-27 has been finalized.

**04. The details of the decision are as follows:**

**4.1 Hostel Allotment Policy for academic year 2026-27.**

**(i) For B.Tech. Students:**

- a. The first preference for hostel accommodation will be given to Outside Delhi Category students (as mentioned in admission slip).
- b. Applicants belonging to PH category (as per admission record) may be provided hostel accommodation under PH Category.
- c. NRI (DASA) students will be treated as Outside Delhi Category students.
- d. All NRI (DASA) students who have their permanent address in Delhi will be considered at par with Delhi category students for hostel allotment.
- e. Those students who are from outside Delhi but passed their 12th examination from a school located in the NCT of Delhi, provided they produce a certificate for their stay in school hostels during senior secondary school only from recognized school (Certificate from the principal of the school to be uploaded).

f. Delhi category students having some serious medical issues (verified from DTU, UHC) may be considered for hostel allotment.

g. Delhi category students whose parents are transferred outside Delhi.

h. For remaining Delhi Category students of B.Tech. preference will be given on the basis of distance from DTU and availability of seats.

i. Students having backlog, except point 4.1 (i) b may be considered for hostel allotment, however, they will be given last preference subject to the availability of seats.

## (ii) For B.Design/M.Tech./M.Tech (R)/MBA/MSc/IMSc./M.Des./PHD(F) students

a. Hostel accommodation will be provided on the basis of distance.

### Note:

a. No fee (Hostel/Mess) will be refunded once paid, it can only be considered in cases where a student completely withdraws from their programme at the University.

b. No accommodation will be provided to sponsored/part-time candidates.

c. Due to the limited availability of hostel accommodation, preference is primarily given to B.Tech students. However, in order to maintain academic diversity within the hostels, a certain number of seats are also allocated to students from other programs, including UG, PG, and Ph.D. (Female) courses.

d. No Extension of hostel stay will be allowed beyond Program Duration. However, IMSc students will be provided for first three years only.

e. Students who were previously hostellers and are not recommended by the respective warden will not be considered for hostel accommodation in the subsequent academic year.

f. Hostel residents, who have taken lead role in organizing activities in hostels, will be given preference for hostel allotment as per recommendation of Hostel Authorities.

g. 2<sup>nd</sup> year and onward NRI (DASA) category male students will be given preference for the AC Hostel allotment.

h. PG and onwards course students will be given last preference for the allotment of hostel.


